Requirements by the Community Centre for Services at the hall

- ❖ Covid -19 cases are still rising, and all our users should be mindful of this fact.
 - All persons should not come to the centre if they are displaying any Covid symptoms
- All users should use the NHS track and trace app on entering the building and follow the one-way system (if you do not have a smartphone we will have paper registration)
- All rooms are to be well ventilated, and all persons are to continue to wash their hands or use sanitiser on entry, and where appropriate during use of the facility
- ❖ If there are more than 30 persons and it's difficult to socially distance, face coverings are expected to be worn (that means WCCers in the congregation should wear masks as we are usually over 30 people)

Staff at WCCC have been able to keep the Centre open throughout the Pandemic and Covid Secure and are wanting this to continue. Please cooperate to support this aim

Advice from the WCC Leadership

Please respect the Community Centre's request for people to keep socially distanced and to wear a mask. This means not receiving hugs whilst in the Centre.
